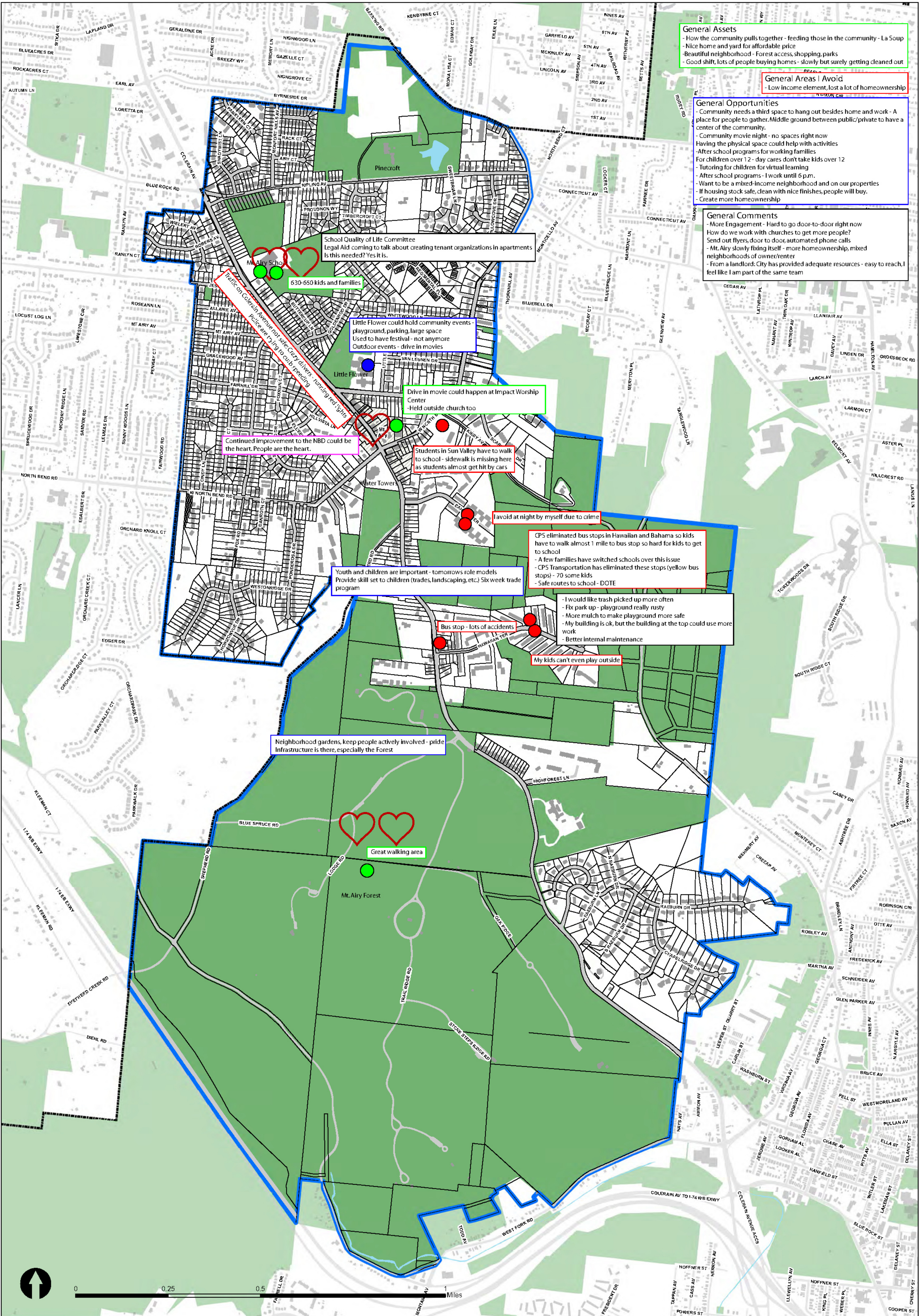

General Opportunities

Students in Sun Valley have to walk to school - sidewalk is missing here as students almost get hit by cars

avoid at night by myself due to crime

CPS eliminated bus stops in Hawaiian and Bahama so kids have to walk almost 1 mile to bus stop so hard for kids to get to school
- A few families have switched schools over this issue
- CPS Transportation has eliminated these stops (yellow bus stops) - 70 some kids
- Safe routes to school - DOTE
